Roles
Judges and Assessors roles are now combined – New for 2017
There are now 3 Level of Judges
Level 1 – (Was Basic Judge) Able to judge at Interclub and County Competitions (Yorkshires)
Level 2 – Able to judge at Regional and National Age Groups
Level 3 – Able to judge at National Champs
Existing Assessors who do not hold a Judges qualification will be required to take Judge Level 1 qualification. Those with a Judges qualification will convert at the appropriate Level.
Level 1 Judge – Judge at Level 1 and Level 2 competitions and Judge at Grade 1 and Grade 2 Assessments
Level 2 Judge – Judge at Level 1, 2,3 and 4 and Judge at Grade 1, 2, 3, 4 and 5 Assessments
Level 3 Judge – Judge at all competitions and Judge all Grades up to and including Grade 6
Chief Recorder/Scorer
Chief Recorder will be required to attend a training course Scorer – New for 2017, there will be an Introduction to Scoring on line course. Scorer Course – 1 day course with test at the end. You may score at competitions without attending a course at the moment.
Team Managers
You would be required to attend the relevant course which is usually held locally, and runs over one evening. A class room ASA approved Safeguarding course, is also held over one evening locally is needed along with an ASA DBS Check. You would be jointly responsible for the girls in the changing room, and help to ensure that they are ready to compete when they are called for. You would also help in preparing the girls hair and make-up. As part of this role you will also be required to ensure that all swimmers know where the competition is to be held, collect log books in advance and liaise with the Competition Secretary to ensure that all entries have been completed.
Chaperones
Assist the Team Manager, no need to attend a course but do still require a DBS Check
Clerk of the Course
You are given the running order of the day, and must ensure that the right girls are lined up in the right order ready to get in the water at the right time. Check swimmer are not breaking any conditions ie have nail varnish or ear rings in. Clerks also liaise with the callers to ensure the right swimmers receive the correct scores.
Competition roles - Will be allocated by the Competition Organisers (This section is one role)
Volunteer – Timekeeper - With the use of a stop-watch, you time each routine to ensure the length is within the timescales set out in the competition rules.
Volunteer – Caller - To read aloud each judges score to the scorers
Volunteer – Spectator Entrance – To collect entry fees from spectators and issue programmes at competitions this role may also include logging the filming register and selling raffle tickets.
Volunteer – Swimmer Registration – To register all competitors, sign log books and alert scorers and Referee of any withdrawals
Volunteer – Field of Play, this role is a general help role on pool side putting chairs away, setting out medals etc
Volunteer – Announcer – Announces everything at the competition
